Getting To The Festival

By Foot

You can enter via any gate, but from Charlbury Yellow Gate / North Lodge is the easiest for accessing the festival via the Pedestrian Box Office. Please note vehicles still use this road throughout the festival, so please walk on the verges and wear bright / reflective clothing if walking home in the evening.

By Car

There are 2 available car parks.

Family Car Park - accessed via BLUE Route OX7 3HL

General / Quiet Car Park - via RED Route OX7 3DF

If you've pre-booked a car park pass, please have your mobile pass ready on arrival to exchange for your car park pass. Alternatively, buy on arrival.

If you're being dropped off, head for GREEN Route, OX7 3EW. Use our Festival Map to find your way.

By Train & Shuttle Bus

Charlbury is the local station, with regular trains from London Paddington. From here you can walk to the festival, it's approx. 1.5miles, but please be aware countryside roads are winding.

Shuttle Busses will be running throughout the weekend, between Charlbury station and the festival. £3 single, £5 return. Cash only.

Shuttle Bus Times

Timings subject to change

Use Bus Stop 1 & enter via the Pick Up Drop Off gate.

Arrival and Check In

Once you arrive, head to the relevant Wristband Exchange to exchange your mobile QR code ticket for your non-camping festival wristband. **Don't rely on signal at the festival. Save your mobile QR code tickets to your phone wallet app before you arrive.**

If you have any issues with your tickets head straight to the relevant Box Office before proceeding to the wristband exchange.

Alcohol Limits

No outside alcohol is permitted in the arena so please do not bring this with you as it will be confiscated and we do not have a service to return this. Bar staff have the right to refuse service if you cannot produce valid I.D.

Restricted Items - Read our full list before packing.

Arena Map & Opening Timings

The Main Arena opens from 07:45 daily (from 14:00 Thursday) and winds down around 04:00 (00:00 Thursday & Sunday). It is closed on Monday. Explore our Map for a better look at the festival.

The Lakes

Use of the lakes is only permitted during the lake opening hours 08:00*-18:00 (*from 14:00 Thursday). No detergents, glitter, chemicals or inflatables in the lakes. Please shower before entering. Only use biodegradable glitter and always remove this with a face wipe that you dispose of properly, don't wash it off, it goes in the water stream.

Litter & Recycling

Use the bins provided. There's a 3 bin system across the festival to separate Compostable, Recyclable and Not Recyclable waste, please use these correctly.
